Visitors To ensure physical distancing is possible, please inform the Home in advance if more than 4 people will be visiting at a time. Proper hand hygiene and PPE along with physical distancing is essential to ensure the health and safety of everyone in the home Fully immunized means the individual has received 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine and received their final dose at least 14 days ago	Randomized testing (Rapid Antigen test) will be completed on people who provide proof of full immunization status If proof of vaccination is not provided, a Rapid Antigen test is required on all visiting days. May proceed to resident's room before results are done Exemptions: Previously COVID-19 positive within 90 days of the positive test or those visiting a resident at end of life.

No eye protection required for indoor or outdoor visits Permitted to eat or drink during visit in designated areas	May visit indoors or outdoors Physical distancing of 2 metres must be maintained, however brief hugs permitted Not permitted to eat or drink during visit	Not permitted while resident in isolation or if resides in a declared outbreak area.	Must wear medical masks provided by the Home at all times while indoors Non-medical masks are permitted and no eye protection required, when a distance of 2 metres is maintained during a scheduled outdoor visit May visit with more than 1 resident in the home on different neighbourhoods. Proper hand hygiene and PPE use along with physical distancing is essential to ensure the health and safety of everyone in the home.	No testing required for outdoor visitors Randomized testing (Rapid Antigen test) will be completed on people who provide proof of full immunization status If proof of vaccination is not provided, a Rapid Antigen test is required on all visiting days. Must wait for results before proceeding to indoor visit. Support Workers/Contractors - same process as general visitors
