 ESSENTIAL CAREGIVER Residents can designate 4 caregivers. Existing designated caregivers remain in place. Caregivers designated after Dec.15/21 must be fully vaccinated. Caregivers designated before Dec. 15 must be fully vaccinated by Feb. 21, 2022 (2 doses) Must receive a third dose of COVID-19 vaccine by March 14, 2022 for those eligible before March 14, 2022. For those eligible on or after March 14, 2022, must provide proof of receiving a third dose within 30 days of being eligible. Max. 3 visitors per resident at a time (unless in outbreak or isolation). This includes general visitors. Must pass screening and receive rapid antigen test on every entry to the Home Must complete quarterly Infection, Prevention & Control (IPAC) education before 1st visit of each quarter 	May have physical contact with fully vaccinated resident May support in designated dining area or join in activities as space allows Masks required at all times.
