<p>ESSENTIAL CAREGIVER</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Residents can designate 4 caregivers. Existing designated caregivers remain in place. Caregivers designated after Dec.15/21 must be fully vaccinated. • Caregivers designated before Dec. 15 must be fully vaccinated by Feb. 21, 2022 (2 doses) • Must receive a third dose of COVID-19 vaccine by March 14, 2022 for those eligible before March 14, 2022. For those eligible on or after March 14, 2022, must provide proof of receiving a third dose within 30 days of being eligible. • Max. 3 visitors per resident at a time (unless in outbreak or isolation). This includes general visitors. • Must pass screening and receive rapid antigen test on every entry to the Home • Must complete quarterly Infection, Prevention & Control (IPAC) education before 1st visit of each quarter 	<p>May have physical contact with fully vaccinated resident</p> <p>May support in designated dining area or join in activities as space allows</p> <p>Masks required at all times. NOT Permitted to eat or drink during visit</p>	<p>1 designated caregiver at a time may visit in resident's room/isolation room if resident is in isolation or resides in a declared outbreak area.</p> <p>All necessary PPE must be worn, including eye protection.</p>	<p>Caregivers who have not received any COVID-19 vaccinations are unable to enter the Home. Window visits with the use of phones and/or video calls can be arranged.</p> <p>Outdoor Visits are resumed, dependent on weather conditions as outside visiting areas are not heated</p> <p>Must wear medical masks provided by the Home at all times</p> <p>Fully vaccinated means the individual has received 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine.</p>	<p>Screening of all caregivers before entry on every visit to the home.</p> <p>Testing (Rapid Antigen) of all caregivers before entry on every visit to the home. <p>NON-ESSENTIAL GENERAL VISITOR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Max. 3 visitors per resident at a time (unless in outbreak or isolation). This includes caregivers. • Must pass screening and receive rapid antigen test on every entry to the Home. • Must be fully vaccinated with 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine 	<p>May have physical contact with fully vaccinated resident</p> <p>May support in designated dining area or join in activities as space allows</p> <p>Masks required at all times. NOT Permitted to eat or drink during visit</p>	<p>Not permitted while resident in isolation or if resides in a declared outbreak area.</p>	<p>Visitors who have not received any COVID-19 vaccinations are unable to enter the Home.</p> <p>Window visits with the use of phones and/or video calls can be arranged.</p> <p>Outdoor Visits are resumed, dependent on weather conditions as outside visiting areas are not heated</p> <p>Must wear medical masks provided by the Home at all times</p> <p>Fully vaccinated means the individual has received 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine</p>	<p>Screening of all visitors before entry on every visit to the home.</p> <p>Testing (Rapid Antigen) of all visitors before entry on every visit to the home. Day Absences <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The use of medical masks and following infection, prevention and control practices is encouraged • Actively screen residents upon return • Rapid test and PCR test as per the current Ministry Directives • Although it is encouraged, the individuals accompanying a resident on their absence is not required to be vaccinated. 	Compassionate/ End of Life	Permitted	Permitted
	Short-term Essential (less than 24 hrs)	Permitted	Not permitted
	Short-term social Max 1 day, not overnight	Permitted - resumed for any resident regardless of vaccination status	Not permitted
	Temporary - SOCIAL (2 days or overnight)	Permitted – resumed for residents with at least 3 COVID- 19 vaccine doses. Although it is encouraged, the individuals the resident will be visiting are not required to be vaccinated.	Not permitted
	Off-site group excursions (Recreation outings)	Permitted	Not permitted
Social Gatherings	Organized Events / Social Gatherings	Cohorting of residents for higher-risk activities, such as singing and exercise Limit of 10 residents for group programming / activities Physical distancing can be relaxed; limited capacity in a room Enhanced precautions required Maintain same activity groups as much as possible	Individual / door to door programming only for area(s) in outbreak and isolated residents (caregiver permitted)
Dining	Communal Dining	Consistent seating of residents at same table – physical distancing can be relaxed. 2 m distancing between diners at different tables as much as possible Fully immunized staff & caregivers may accompany fully immunized residents for meals. Must keep masks on at all times and therefore not permitted to eat.
