Medical Emergency CODE BLUE

Medical Emergency - Code Blue

PURPOSE

1. To ensure that all necessary steps are followed in the event that a resident, staff, volunteer or visitor find themselves in medical distress.

INITIATING THE CODE BLUE

- 1. As soon as it has been discovered that a person is in medical distress, the Charge Nurse must be notified immediately.
- 2. The Charge Nurse will take control of the situation.

PROCEDURE

- 1. The Charge Nurse will assess the person for injury and the ability to breathe.
- 2. If it's a resident, the Charge Nurse will direct another Nurse to check the resident's chart for resuscitation efforts.
- 3. If required, the Charge Nurse will direct a staff member to retrieve the defibrillator, while commencing CPR.
- 4. The defibrillator is located:
 - The Lodge: outside Pine Lane Entrance
 - The Villa: first floor, main entrance
 - **The Manor**: first floor in the lobby by the elevators
- 5. The Charge nurse will direct a person to call "9-1-1" and to meet the first responders at the Front Entrance.
- 6. The Charge Nurse will ensure that the resident's family members are contacted and transfer documents are prepared.
- 7. If the medical event occurs to staff, volunteers or visitors the Charge Nurse will endeavour to locate and notify next of kin.
