 CAREGIVER A Caregiver is a type of Essential Visitor designated by the Elder. Elders can designate an unlimited number of Caregivers. The Caregiver policy provides a definition and outlines responsibilities. Must pass screening and receive rapid antigen test on every entry to the Home. Must complete quarterly Infection, Prevention & Control (IPAC) education before 1st visit of each quarter. 	May have physical contact with Elder. May support in designated dining area or join in activities as space allows. NOT permitted to eat or drink during indoor visits.	1 designated caregiver at a time may visit in Elder's room/isolation room if Elder is in isolation or resides in a declared outbreak area.
