Infection Control – Beth Schenk

Respiratory Syncytial virus (RSV) is a major cause of lower respiratory illness, particularly among infants, young children and older adults, affecting lungs and airways.

Through the **High Risk Older Adult RSV Vaccine Program**, adults aged 60 years and older residing in long term care homes qualify.

With RSV virus on the rise, the IPAC focus for January is ensuring that all consenting Elders receive this important respiratory vaccine. POA's will be called this week asking for telephone consent.
