## Signing in with the Accusheild Kiosk

In accordance with the *Fixing Long-Term Care Act, 2021* and Ontario Regulation 246/22, all visitors to the Manor **are required to sign in** using the Accushield kiosk.

This ensures compliance with the mandatory visitor log requirements, which include:

- Visitor's Name and Contact Information
- Date and Time of Visit
- Name of Elder Being Visited

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we work together to ensure a safe and supportive environment for the Elders, staff and families.

If staff notice you do not have the name tag on, you will be asked to go sign in.

#### Pet Visiting

We would like to provide a friendly reminder to all families bringing in their pets and the general policies surrounding pet visits. All pets must be on a leash or in a carrier to and from your loved one's room. No pets are to roam freely around the home; Visitors must maintain control of their pets at all times. Pets are only to visit their loved ones. Although we have animal lovers in the home, only Animal Therapy Dogs have the certifications to visit all Elders. Cleaning up after your animals is a must! Please be courteous and pick up after your pets, to help keep our property clean.

All County homes require the visiting animal to have a file on hand with their updated vaccines. This can be dropped off to Nicole Roegiest (Recreation and Leisure Supervisor) as she will me managing the files. When submitting please note the Elder the pet will be visiting. If the pets do not have updated vaccines, they are not to enter the home. This is to protect our Elders, Staff and other visiting pets. If you would like a copy of the policies, they are located at the front desk, or can be requested from Nicole Roegiest.
