Nursing Updates

We are very excited to be moving forward with Jubo Health VitalLink for our head injury monitoring after an Elder experiences a fall. This allows vital signs and Range of Motion to be uploaded directly into the Elders' Care Plan. Training for this has been completed with all Registered Staff. We are also continuing to move forward with the Registered Nursing Association of Ontario (RNAO) new Clinical Pathways tool and have implemented the first three assessments. We will now begin the training required for the next two assessments.

We were fortunate to have two consolidating Bachelor of Science Nursing students from Lambton College complete their final placement with us and we will also have two Practical Nursing students complete their placement at the Lodge.

April 14-20th we recognized the hard work and dedication of our volunteers!
