The Manor Auxiliary

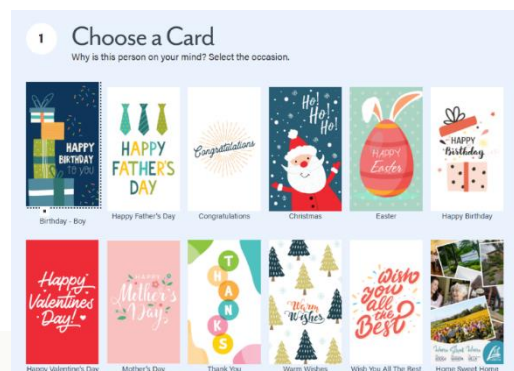
